## **NEW EARLY CHILDHOOD LEARNING CENTER OPENS IN WELLSTON – PROVIDES FREE PROGRAMS. OPEN HOUSE PLANNED**

(St. Louis, MO) United 4 Children is pleased to announce the opening of the **24:1 Early Childhood Learning Center** in Wellston at 6633 Dr. Martin Luther King Drive. The 24:1 Early Childhood Learning Center provides children with the necessary skills in order to meet the Missouri Early Learning Standards. The objective of the program is to ensure all children are ready for kindergarten through focused literacy and math experiences, strong family partnerships, and connections to needed direct special services within an inclusive enriching environment. Daily sessions are for children 2 ½ to 5 years old free of charge to family residents of the Normandy Schools Collaborative.

Program sessions include four half-days each week Mondays through Thursdays 8:30am to 12 Noon and 1pm to 4:30pm. The program runs year-round and is operated in partnership with Beyond Housing.
